The composition of this watercolour relates closely to Prout's lithograph *The Riva degli Schiavoni, Venice*, published in *Sketches in France, Switzerland and Italy* in 1839 (see T. Wilcox, *Samuel Prout, A Grand Tour in Watercolour*, London, 2017, p. 86, fig. 19). In both this watercolour and the lithograph Prout has moved the two Byzantine columns of St Theodore and St Mark onto the quayside.
