Description

Edward Lear (1812-1888)
View of Chiaia, Naples

Chiaia sits on the seafront to the west of the centre of Naples. To the far right of the present watercolour is the Castel dell'Ovo jutting out into the sea. In front is the Casino Francavilla with the dome of the Chiesa delle Crocelle al Chiatamonte beyond.

Lear first visited Naples in the summer of 1838.
